WHY AND WHAT FOR

In question form, "why" and "what for" are used to ask about the purpose of something. To answer these questions, you can use the conjuctions so, so that and in order to. Here are some examples:

- 1. Rudi : <u>why</u> are the children wearing hats?
- Mother : they're <u>wearing</u> the hats <u>so</u> they won't get sunburned.
- 2. Adi : <u>why</u> are you walking so fast?
- Nina : i have to hurry, <u>so</u> I will not miss the 7 o'clock train.
- 3. Rio : why do you ask me to study harder?
- Mom : you need it in order to get an A in English.
- 4. Nana : <u>what</u> did you do that <u>for</u>?
 - Alice : <u>to</u> clean my table.
- 5. Novi : <u>what</u> are you here for?
- Indri : <u>to</u> improve my English , of course.
- 6. Rudy : <u>what</u> do people need to work for?
- Nia : to make money and perform their skill, of course.
- 7. Dinda : <u>why</u> did you speak that loudly?
 - Ana : so that everybody could hear me

- Beni : <u>Should</u> we go to the drugstore and buy some for her, Siti?
- Siti : Actually we <u>can make</u> such water ourselves with water, sugar, and salt.
- Dayu : That's a good idea The closest drug store is quite far from here.
- Udin : Or you <u>can</u> try guava leaves. In fact, I have bought some for you. The taste is terrible but it stops you from diarrhea.
- Dayu : <u>No way</u>. I have tried it once and I could not stand the taste. It was very bitter.
- Udin : You are right. I can't stand the taste either.
- Dayu : Actually, this is a good lesson for me. I never care about what I eat.
- Beni : I've noticed that, Dayu. I saw you eat guava but you didn't wash it first. Listen everybody, <u>never forget</u> to wash your fruits and vegetables before you eat them <u>so that</u> you will not take any germs into your stomach.
- Dayu : Yes, Boss. You are right. We should always clean our food well. I <u>should</u> be more careful now.
- Lina : And, Dayu often buys foods from the street vendors. I think we all know that the foods are not always covered properly, and the bowls or the plates to serve the foods are not always washed properly either.
- Dayu : I know. But, where should I get such nice foods?
- Edo : I think you <u>need</u> to <u>bring</u> your lunch from home. Home made food is healthy, and you <u>can</u> also save your money for more useful things.
- Dayu : That's very true.
- Lina : Dayu, you look very pale. I think you <u>need</u> to see the doctor soon <u>in order to get</u> the right medicine for your diarrhea. You <u>should</u> not take the diarrhea lightly.
- Dayu : No, I shouldn't. Actually, my mom is on the way from her office. She is going home early in order to take me to the hospital. I hope I will be in the right hand soon.
- Beni : You will, I'm sure.
