Countable nouns are things we can count. For example: "apple" and "doughnut". We can count apple. We can have one, two, or more doughnuts.

Uncountable nouns are things we cannot count. For example: "water" and "oil". We cannot count water. We count a glass of water or bottles of water, but we cannot count "water" it self.

How many and how much

We use how many with countable nouns.

- How many apples do you buy?

We use how much with uncountable nouns.

- How much water do you buy?

How much rice do you buy?

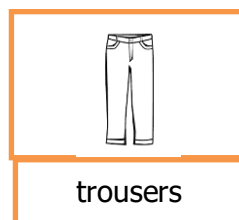
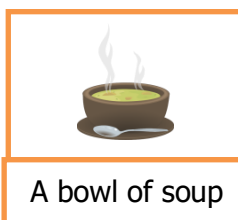
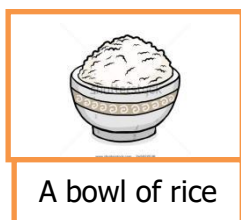
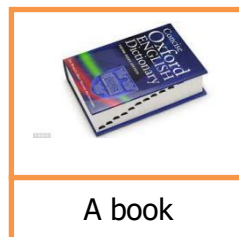
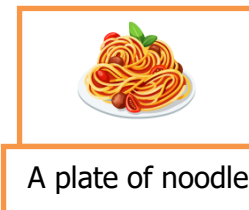
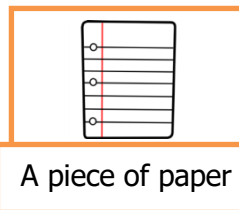
How much sugar does he buy?
