

UNIT 12 NOUNS

A. Explanation

There are two kinds of nouns, they are countable and uncountable nouns:

1. Countable Nouns

Countable nouns are things that can be counted. We can count them. It can be formed in a singular or plural noun.

For example: dog, cat, chair, car, house, suitcase, plate, moon, sun etc

2. Uncountable Nouns

Uncountable nouns are things that can't be counted one by one. It is almost in a group of mass, such as: kilograms, litre, etc.

For example: ink, sugar, salt, etc



We do not say one water or two waters, but we can count such a noun with the following measurement.

- the number of litres/kilos
two kilos of potatoes
one litre of water
- the containers
a bottle of water
three jars of jam
- other measurement words
two slices of bread
a piece of chocolate
a loaf of bread
a bar of chocolate





A. Explanation



Pattern:

1. Quantity:

How many + CN + aux. Verb + S + C?
How much UN

Example:

- A: How many hot dogs does Andika buy?
B: He buys three hot dogs
- A: How much syrup do you drink?
B: I drink two cup of syrup

2. Price:

How much + aux. Verb + UN/CN + S + C?

Example:

- X: How much is the hot dog that Andika buy?
Y: The hot dog is Rp 10.000,-
- X: How much is the syrup that you drink?
Y: It is \$6
