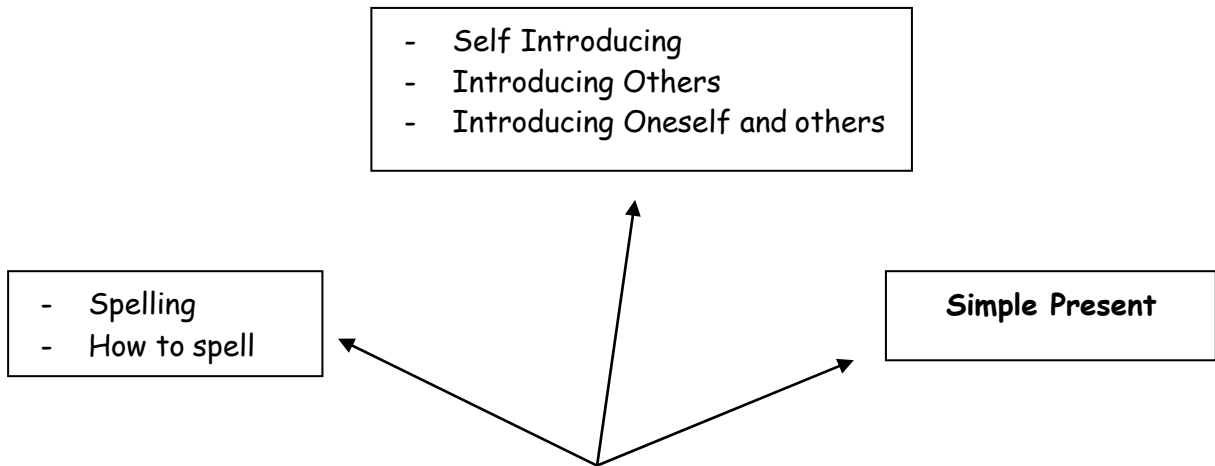
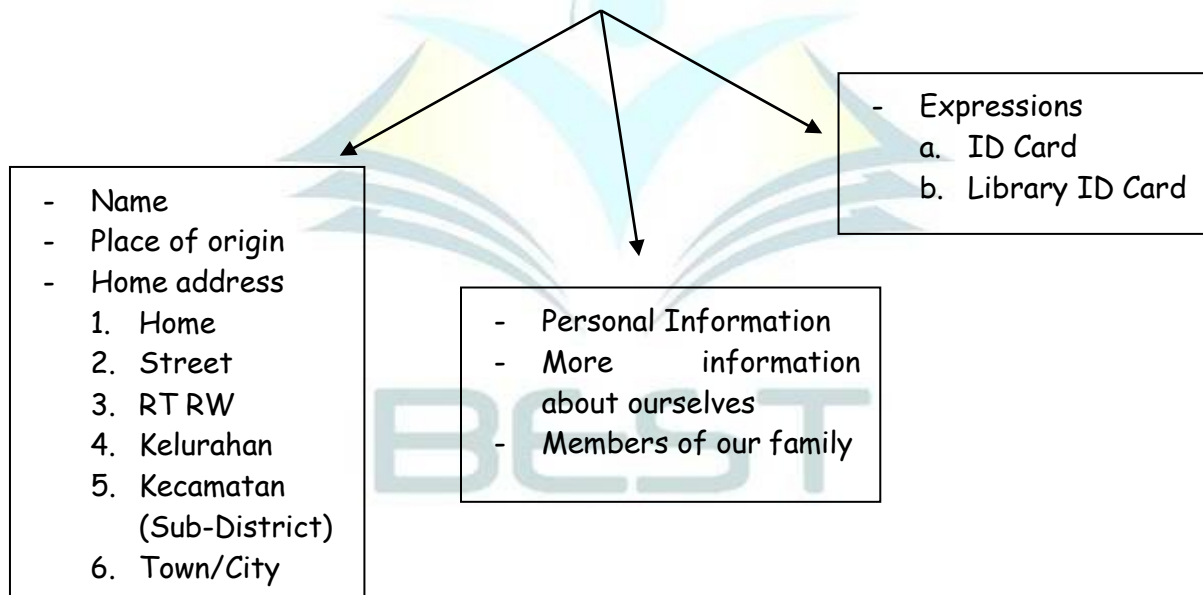

Explanation to tell other people about our names, our origins, and our home address.

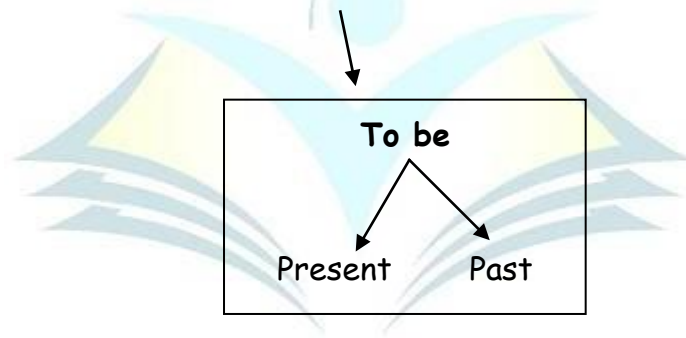

AUXILIARY VERB

A. Explanation

There are two types of **to be**, they are:

- To be for **present** time → am / is / are
- To be for **past** time → was / were

To be for **present** time

a. For singular noun:

- She → She is / she"s → She is not / she isn"t
- He → He is / he"s → He is not / he isn"t
- It → It is / it"s → It is not / it isn"t
- I → I am / I"m → I am not / I"m not

b. For plural noun:

- You → You are / you"re → You are not / you aren"t
- They → They are / they"re → They are not / they aren"t
- We → We are / we"re → We are not / we aren"t
