

- Ardi : Not much. That"s more than enough. Thank you very much, Yoga.
- Yoga : Anytime.

"Can I borrow" is used to ask somebody to lend you something that you need.

**"Which one**" is used to ask somebody to point about something or someone (in a limited number) exactly.

"How many" and "How much" as the question words:

Use "How many" when you ask about countable noun.

Use "How much" when you ask about uncountable noun.
